We use 'Just enough support' principles to ensure a strengths-based approach that encourages people to set ambitious goals that maximise independence, wellbeing and community integration.

Eligibility & referrals

We welcome referrals from local authorities, direct payors and individuals funded by health services. This offer is for adults aged 18 or over diagnosed with learning disabilities, acquired brain injury and/or physical disabilities and autism.

In supported living, people have their own tenancy agreement and are responsible for their own bills and cost of living, which we can support with where required.

We can also help with sourcing accommodation in partnership with our trusted housing providers.

To help cover costs individuals may be entitled to a range of benefits such as the housing benefit part of Universal Credit, Personal Independence Payments, Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) and Attendance Allowance (AA).

Person-centred planning

We conduct comprehensive assessments to gain a deep understanding of individual's needs, preferences, and support requirements. Our skilled and experienced teams work with every person we support to create a personalised, outcome-focused plan to achieve their aspirations.

We check in regularly with people supported, as well as their families, professionals involved in their care and support staff, providing us with ongoing opportunities to address concerns, celebrate successes, and fine-tune support strategies as needed.
